Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop employing only 4 people. Overall sales for that particular year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 employees and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. At present, Cascade is among the top global makers within the material handling business.

Design and manufacturing of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively engage in new business opportunities. All through the final sixty years, the industry of material handling has developed into a really advanced field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best supplier of forklift accessories and different associated items. The company feels certain in their skill to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

Through the 1950's, Cascade began to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was built in 1956, in order to house all of the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty employees and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second manufacturing facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the business altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in the year 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are made globally thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and the year 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of five firms, including the international leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
